These service offerings will include a member of our caring staff spending time with your family to gather information and learn about your loved one. Also included is staffing prior to and following the funeral service and visiting hours; arranging for funeral services with clergy, church, cemetery, etc; transfer of deceased to the funeral home, embalming, dressing, casketing and cosmetology for viewing; use of staff and equipment for visiting hours, funeral ceremony in our facility, church or other location and at the cemetery or crematory; use of funeral coach and service/flower van.

These service offerings will include a member of our caring staff spending time with your family to gather information and learn about your loved one. We will assist your family in planning and creating a meaningful Life Celebration, as well as a discussion on merchandise options and selections. We will also explain all the available options for unique ways to enhance the services.

Also included is staffing prior to and following the funeral service and visiting hours; arranging for memorial services with clergy, church, cemetery, etc.; transfer of deceased to the funeral home and crematory, minimum preparation, sanitizing and refrigeration of deceased; use of staff and equipment for visiting hours (if requested), funeral ceremony in our facility, church or other location and at the cemetery or crematory; use of funeral coach and service/flower van for the day of the service.

Two Day Life Celebration Remembrance Service [\$5,650.00] Cremation followed by visiting hours the previous night and a memorial service the following day with local burial immediately following.

One Day Life Celebration Remembrance Service [\$5,350.00] Cremation followed by visiting hours with a memorial service the same day and local burial immediately following. (No visiting hours \$5,150.00)

Graveside Commemoration Service [\$4,125.00]

Cremation followed by a graveside funeral service at a local cemetery

Itemized Fervices

Basic Service of Funeral Director and Staff [\$2,950.00]

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff include, but not limited to responding to the initial request for services, conducting the arrangement conference, preparation of biographical and statistical data, examination of financial settlement options, preparation and filing of papers, permits, and authorizations, coordination with those providing other services, such as churches, cemeteries, crematories and others; preparation and placement of obituary notices, retention and care of remains prior to commencement of post death activities, overhead expenses relative to our facilities and operations such as occupancy, administrative, insurance, inventory, equipment and other costs. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you have selected.

Embalming [\$650.00]

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary if you have selected certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with a viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it (such as a basic cremation or immediate burial).

Our services include set-up of the visitation area, placement of remains, positioning of floral displays and supervision and parking lot attendants and pallbearers during the hours of visitation and or the funeral ceremony and committal or other disposition service. Also, our services include coordinating the arrangements for the ceremony and the use of the funeral home when used for ceremony.

Alternative Selections

Forwarding of Remains to another Funeral Home [\$2,885.00]

This charge includes removal of remains to this funeral home, a portion of the basic services of funeral director and staff, embalming, obtaining permits and transportation to regional airports. This charge does not include a casket, visitation, rites or ceremonies prior to forwarding remains or container used to forward remains.

Receiving of Remains from another Funeral Home [\$2,250.00]

This charge includes receiving the remains from another funeral home, the overnight sheltering of the remains, a portion of the basic services of funeral director and staff, the obtaining of necessary permits and authorizations, and the local transportation to the cemetery or crematory, this charge does not include viewing, ceremony, merchandise.

Receiving of Cremated Remains from another Funeral Home [\$395.00]

This charge includes all of the above services

Immediate Burial [\$2,795.00 to \$6,255.00]

Our charges include basic services of funeral director and staff, local transfer of remains to the funeral home, the overnight sheltering of remains, sanitary care of the remains, the obtaining of necessary permits and authorizations, local transportation to the cemetery. This charge does not include a casket and outer burial container, embalming, visitation or ceremony, or cemetery expenses.

Basic Cremation [\$2,900.00 to \$6,100.00]

Our charges include a portion of basic services of funeral director and staff, local transfer of remains to funeral home, the overnight shelter of the remains, sanitary care of the remains, obtaining of necessary permits and authorizations, local transportation to the crematory. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are constructed of corrugated cardboard and fiberboard. (Prices include Crematory Fee and Medical Examiner Fee)


